## Call to Order and President's Report: Abby Adams

We have a lot to cover tonight but I wanted to take a minute to thank a few people who have been hard at work but before I do, I wanted to give Nancy a collective Happy Birthday from us all on the board where would we be without Nancy and all that she does for our school and most especially our children!

- Report on Teacher Survey: see other pdf for full report
- This year was an anonymous survey, unlike in person interviews done in past years
- Largest feedback was on parent helpers.
  - Teachers appreciate parent helpers and see the value in having parents have a window into a child's day.
  - Parent Helping has greatly improved over the past few years.
  - That said, punctuality is still a sticking point; parents are having a hard time arriving by 8:45 am.
    - It can help if a parent acknowledges if they are late.
  - Cell phone use is an issue; parents using cell phones while parent helping
  - Some parents prefer to be with their child one on one while they are there, but it is really better for the greater studio if they can integrate into the greater group and be a part of other children's play.
- Very positive feedback about Nancy. 8 out of 9 said Nancy always provides the support they need. Support, thoughtfulness and cheerfulness.
- Co-teaching relationships: some said their co-teachers are amazing, supportive and thoughtful. Some discussed furthering their working relationship and using mediated meetings.
- Faculty Collaboration, some would like more of this since it happens organically but could happen more if intentional.
- Relationship with Decordova Learning & Engagement was appreciated.
- 8 satisfied with salary, 1 dissatisfied. Making sure that raises keep up with inflation.
- 9 out 9 satisfied with vacation
- Professional growth opportunities do exist
- 9 out of 9 feel respected and appreciated by parents
- Feedback overall feels smoother than last year
- At pick up time, parents should be watching their kids, teachers are no longer on duty watching the kids once a parent arrives.
